Just in Time for Brooklyn's Summer



OPENING SOON An eight-ton, crescent-shaped stainless steel sculpture is installed yesterday at a new 400-foot pier at Northside Piers, a mixeduse development on the Williamsburg waterfront that will feature 800 homes and a public esplanade. In commissioning the sculpture, the developers called for a unique shade structure with a seating area. It was designed by Mark Gibian, an artist who has lived in Williamsburg for 28 years.
